
### ***Please Join An Exciting Conservation Partnership with Audubon's Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary for 2017-2018***

Your partnership with Audubon's Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary supports Corkscrew's conservation programs in the Western Everglades and helps provide a hopeful vision of Southwest Florida's future.

Audubon has more than a century of conservation experience in Southwest Florida, dating back to pioneer days and the protection of wading birds. Fifty years later, the National Audubon Society's protection made possible the rescue of Corkscrew's old-growth forest from logging, and the establishment of Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary in 1954.

Today, Corkscrew is a 13,000-acre nature preserve that includes the Blair Audubon Visitor Center. It is considered the "crown jewel" in the network of National Audubon Society nature centers, and hosts 100,000 visitors annually. It is a National Natural Landmark, a Ramsar-designated "Wetland of International Importance," an Important Birding Area, a gateway to the Florida Birding Trail, and a member of the Old-Growth Forest Network.

Our team of resource managers, researchers, and scientists are dedicated to protecting the Sanctuary as well as the vast, interconnected habitats that define the Western Everglades and the critical watersheds of Southwest Florida. Our educators are devoted to ecological and scientific literacy and to inspiring appreciation of wild places and wildlife. In so doing, they can ensure that current and future generations understand the value of the greater Everglades.







### Visitor Center, Nature Store, Gallery Café, and Boardwalk
